In 2014, the Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority (QCAA) introduced an award to recognise and reward Queensland's top-performing senior students for outstanding academic achievement. These prestigious awards, known as the Queensland Certificate of Education Achievement (QCE) Award, were presented by the Minister for Education last Saturday, in a ceremony acknowledging Queensland's top Year 12 students of 2015.

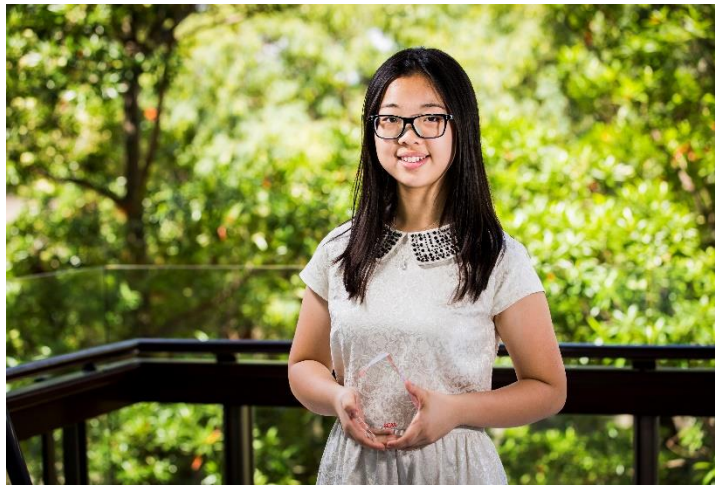
